(Explanation of terms)

Standards

Numbers of doctors and nurses to be deployed at hospitals designated by the Medical Care Law.

Complying rate

"Percentage of hospitals satisfying the designated number of doctors/nurses" in "hospitals for which on-site investigation are conducted".

Sufficient/insufficient

Of hospitals for which on-site investigation are conducted, those satisfying standards are counted as "sufficient" and those not satisfying the numerical standards are counted as "insufficient".
