

Note: Among those Japanese remaining in China after the war, those who were separated from their parents in the confusion due to USSR's entry into the war, and who were adopted by Chinese parents and brought up without knowing their native identity are called "Japanese orphans remaining in China after the war," and those who, for example, have lost their means of living, married Chinese men and remained in China are called "Japanese women remaining in China after the war."
