

How to make MHLW Karuta (playing cards)

* To guardians:

We created Karuta about the policies of the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW). We hope this will help you and your children to gain a better understanding of our policies.

Things to prepare

- 1 12 sheets of A4-sized cardboard.
- 2 Glue
- 3 Cutter or scissors

How to make Karuta

- 1 Cut off 12 pieces of picture cards and reading card along “the dotted line.”
- 2 Paste them on the cardboard with glue. (You can prevent the cards from getting warped to some degree by pressing them under the dictionary, etc. when they are getting dry.)
- 3 Cut the cards with a cutter or scissors after they are completely dry.
